

Player Rankings

OCC Player Rankings will be a system of rankings for Omaha Cricket Club Players based on their recent performances and indicates the players' level of competency along the lines of batting, bowling and all-round performance.

OCC Player Rankings will be a very basic system that records the runs scored and wickets taken by a player during the league matches and tournaments, and then ranks them according to the points awarded for the runs scored and wickets taken.

OCC Player Rankings will be published on the website (<u>www.omahacricket.org</u>) and then updated every two weeks by the Web Administrator.

Please refer below for Batting Points, Bowling Points and All Rounder Points.



Batting Rankings

Minimum Qualification: 5 Runs

Bonus Points shall be awarded to differentiate each player's batting performance between one or more matches played and total matches played.

Example:

Player A scores 90 runs in one match and gets awarded 9 Points plus 8 Bonus Points, thus garnering 17 Total Points.

Player B scores 90 runs in ten matches (9 runs per match) and gets awarded 1 Point per match, thus garnering only 9 Total Points.

Total Points shall be the sum of Points and Bonus Points awarded per match.

If more than 170 runs shall be scored, the table will be expanded in progression to determine the awarded points.

Bowling Rankings

Minimum Qualification: 1 Wicket

Bonus Points shall be awarded to differentiate each player's bowling performance between one or more matches played and total matches played.

Example:

Player A takes 7 wickets in one match and gets awarded 7 Points plus 6 Bonus Points, thus garnering 13 Total Points.

Player B takes 10 wickets in ten matches (1 wicket per match) and gets awarded 1 Point per match, thus garnering only 10 Total Points.

Total Points shall be the sum of Points and Bonus Points awarded per match.

All Rounder Rankings

Minimum Qualification: 30 Runs & 3 Wickets

Total Points will be the sum of points awarded for Total Runs scored and Total Wickets taken respectively.

Example:

Player A scores 90 runs in ten matches and gets awarded 7 Batting Points.

Player A takes 8 wickets in ten matches and gets awarded 6 Bowling Points.

Total All Rounder Points for Player A shall be 13 Points (7 Batting Points plus 6 Bowling Points).

If more than 150 runs shall be scored, the table will be expanded in progression to determine the awarded points.

If more than 15 wickets shall be taken, the table will be expanded in progression to determine the awarded points.
